Extra Supplies

There a few more items we have added to our supplies that may not be on any of these lists.

- Wind up radios not needing batteries and shaker flashlights not needing batteries
- Water purification method that does not use electricity as this will be one of the first things to go
- Cheesecloth for straining the big clumps out of water before purifying
- Unscented Baby Wipes for washing your body, dishes, or in place of toilet paper. They take
 up less space and are already wet. Even if they dry out, they can be reactivated by just adding
 water.
- Silicone potholders or gloves or welding gloves for use by hot campfires
- Baby shampoo is good for washing body and hair because it rinses easily and is alkaline
- Bug and water proof storage containers

- Super Sealer is also a welcome item
- Hand grinders and choppers to grind fresh meat or grains
- Basic Seasonings and spices as you won't be able to run to the store for these
- Lots of Salt to be used to preserve fresh meat, healing, bartering, and preservation of dead bodies
- Trash Bags & zip lock bags all sizes used for potty, garbage, bodies
- Magic markers waterproof to mark zip bags, containers, and bodies (dead or alive) with name and soc sec no., a path for others to follow on trees or rocks
- Board games for children and adults, coloring books including crayons, pens, pencils, paper, both lined and unlined
- Home-made fire starters and water proof matches 6" strips of newspapers rolled fairly tight, tied with string dipped in paraffin and old fashioned matches dipped in paraffin (stored in old prescription bottles with striking strip torn off box and stored inside.
- Prescription meds, Tylenol, Ibuprofen, allergy can be transferred to small labeled zip bags to take up less room.
- OTC meds for burns, infections, bleeding, (septic pencil, sanitary napkins are great for padding wounds) heartburn, diarrhea, constipation, and allergies
- Kitty Litter for use in potty bucket or area pot bucket can be a bucket formerly used for your freeze dired pouches of food
- Nylon Rope and other kinds of twine
- Mosquito netting
- Sterno stoves and sterno fuel cans there are also heat burning cans as well
- Duct Tape (never enough of this)
- Plastic sheeting
- A few women's nylon hose Put a bar of soap in a nylon hose. Tie it to the handle of an empty milk jug filled with water. With another string, tie a small twig on a string to the handle. Poke a hole in the bottom front edge of the jug and stick the twig in it. With another piece of rope tie onto handle and hang in tree for sun to heat. Great way to have hand washing station. Pull out twig to let water flow. Adjust with loosening or tightening lid.
- Tip: Campfire ashes can be used to scrub the bottom of pots used on campfire.

The list can go on and on. Just pray for God to remind you of what you may need.

- (44) Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.
- (45) Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season?
- (46) Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- (47) Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods.

The Lord's Supper

We have done a lot of teaching and prophesying about the False Communion. This does not mean that we should not continue to practice the true sacrament of the Lord's Supper or Communion in our own homes or fellowship groups. The following are suggestions for doing that. We need to remember the purpose of the Passover meal and the importance of trusting Jesus for everything we need in our lives as we realize the perilous times we are living in. When I prepare the sacrament I pray over myself for forgiveness, cleansing, anointing, and for the Lord to prepare the hearts of those who will be receiving it. We usually ask everyone to examine their own hearts before partaking, read the passage pertaining, and sing some praise music before, after, or both. After the sacrament is also a good time to anoint with oil and pray for individual healing. (Recipe found on the Internet)

Unleavened Communion Bread Recipe

1/8 C. Honey

1/8 C. Olive Oil

1/2 C. Water

1/4 t. Salt (sea)

Heat in sauce pan and mix well until it almost burns.

Add to that mix 1/2 C. Whole Wheat Flour and mix well.

Let Cool

Turn out onto floured board and knead until dough looks glazed.

Bake 20-30 minutes at 325 -350 degrees

This can be frozen and thawed when used later.

Communion Wine - Fruit of the Vine

There has always been much controversy about this, so we leave it to personal choice and prayer. If you choose to use real wine, it should be 1 part red wine mixed with 2 parts water as was the custom of the early church fathers. Or, you may use grape juice full strength. The point is to Remember Jesus.

Luke 22:19-20

- (19) And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- (20) Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.
