The power of the Lord is on me. It has shaken me awake as I realize I have just had a prophetic dream.

PROPHETIC DREAM – THE COMING DARKNESS

I was in a long room full of people of all ages. There were both saved, born again believers and non-believers. Nothing in the building indicated it was a church, although it seemed as though we were having some sort of meeting. There were no pews, no podiums, no Bibles that were visible. There were a few folding tables and chairs. It seemed as if the doors and windows were all closed. (A. B.)

All of a sudden we all heard the screams and cries of the people on the outside. We opened the front double doors to see what all the noise was about. There was a carport overhead open roof structure where cars could drive under to let off or pick up passengers. However, I saw no cars. (C.)

What I did see will haunt me and be in my thoughts for a long time. There was lots of smoke. Above the carport roof I saw a thick charcoal grey black cloud of darkness. As I looked out, it was as if it started on my left and went around the building and was coming back around on my right. It was as if the whole city or world was being engulfed in this evil spiritual cloud of darkness.

At the edge of the carport roof I saw a row of spiritual yet real gargoyle type creatures facing my right. They were crouched as if waiting to spring upon the unsuspecting crowd of people. (D.)

As the cloud of darkness continued to overcome the area, I could see a little sliver of blue clouded sky between the crouching evil creatures and the right edge of the cloud of darkness.

There were a few people from the outside running into the building. They were terrorized and had gaping wounds of various magnitudes caused by bite marks and possibly stings. There were also broken bones and lots of bruising. However, I did not see any dead bodies.

The people within the room were ministering (serving) the ones from the outside. They were feeding them and tending to their wounds with bandages and such. (E.)

We were there to rescue the people. We were very aggressive and were climbing in the windows and breaking down the doors. We saw huge lion like creatures carrying off people in their mouths and taking them straight down to the pit where the smoke was coming from. (L. M. N.)

All of a sudden I saw one of those huge lion like creatures in the door way of one of these houses. It filled the entire doorway. He was waiting to devour me or the occupants of the house or anyone who came near. As I faced the creature, he roared at me. The power of the Lord reared up in me and I said, "Shut your mouth in the name of Jesus. You have no power or authority here." A look came over the lion creature's face. It was a combination of anger, disdain, unbelief and finally resignation.

Then the mighty hand of God took charge. The lion creature became encased in the doorway as if he was trapped between the inside door and the outside door. The entire door frame with the creature encased fell out of the house to the ground. The creature was still alive, but his power was temporarily suspended. Unfortunately, there were similar creatures that had crossed over spiritual boundaries just waiting to attack us all. So the battle continued, but that was when the dream ended and I awoke crying, speaking in tongues, and being thankful it was a dream and not reality. (O. P. Q.)

END OF DREAM

As I write this I pray for God to help me remember every detail and to pray for understanding. Prophecy should always be backed up with Scripture and as I began to process this dream, I saw many Scriptures that pertained. I will share just a few here. There were several Scriptures the Lord had revealed to me and after sharing this dream with David the Lord confirmed many of the same Scriptures. I am sure there will be more of the deeper meaning of this prophetic dream in the days to come. David has decided to teach on "The Coming Darkness", so he will be helping us to understand the meaning of this dream.

As I reflected on my encounter with the lion creature, I wondered how I could possibly accomplish such a thing as I am very disabled and can only walk a short distance with the help of a walker. Immediately the Lord spoke to me and said, "Not by your power, but by my power and might!" I believe that the Lord will give us what we need and there will be miraculous healings at the time of the end. I have had many a battle with devils during our personal ministry sessions and have cast many of them out even in my weakened physical condition. When I am weak, He is strong!

Just before I commanded the lion creature to shut his mouth, some thoughts passed through my mind. "I must not doubt! I must not be afraid! Lord, forgive me of my sins and

Matthew 13:24-30

- (24) Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field:

C. Cloud of darkness came silent like a thief

Luke 12:39

- (39) And this know, that if the goodman of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched, and not have suffered his house to be broken through.

- (2) A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there hath not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it, *even* to the years of many generations.

D. Locusts / Scorpions out of the pit and smoke

I described these creatures as gargoyle type creatures although I could not see all the details of their faces. I think they reminded me of gargoyles because they were perched on the edge. Although I know they were not the only ones that were present. It was as if they were part of an army and they were the next line to be dispatched into the war. They were very dark creatures in the cloud of darkness, so I could not distinguish the facial features, only the havoc they perpetrated on their victims. I do think they had wings, huge teeth and very angry expressions on their faces.

Revelation 9:1-11

- (1) And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.
- (2) And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit.
- (3) And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.
- (4) And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.
- (5) And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months: and their torment *was* as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man.
- (6) And in those days shall men seek death, and shall not find it; and shall desire to die, and death shall flee from them.
- (7) And the shapes of the locusts *were* like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads *were* as it were crowns like gold, and their faces *were* as the faces of men.
- (8) And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as *the teeth* of lions.
- (9) And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings *was* as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.
- (10) And they had tails like unto scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power *was* to hurt men five months.
- (11) And they had a king over them, *which is* the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue *is* Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath *his* name Apollyon.

Verse 4: These locusts were not to hurt the grass and most common locusts eat grass.

E. People ministering. We need to be prepared both physically (as God directs) as well as spiritually. The people had to have already had these supplies on hand. Good and faithful servant. (See G. good and faithful servant)

Luke 12:37

(37) Blessed *are* those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.

Matthew 10:24-25

(24) The disciple is not above *his* master, nor the servant above his lord.

(25) It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If

Luke 21:25-28

- (25) And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring;
- (26) Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.

J. One mind and accord

Hebrews 10:22-27

(23) Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;)

(24) And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

(25) Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some *is*; but exhorting *one another*: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

(26) For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

K. Scarves or banners (ensign). We represented the army of God and we are coming after you!

Isaiah 11:10

- (9) They shall run to and fro in the city; they shall run upon the wall, they shall climb up upon the houses; they shall enter in at the windows like a thief.
- (10) The earth shall quake before them; the heavens shall tremble: the sun and the moon shall be dark, and the stars shall withdraw their shining:
- (11) And the LORD shall utter his voice before his army: for his camp *is* very great: for *he is* strong that executeth his word: for the day of the LORD *is* great and very terrible; and who can abide it?

Jude 1:21-23

- (21) Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

- (23) And others save with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

N. Devouring and taking to pit and roaring lion

1 Peter 5:5-11

- (5) Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all *of you* be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.
- (6) Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:
- (7) Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
- (8) Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- (9) Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.
- (10) But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle *you*.
- (11) To him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

O. Power over the enemy

Ephesians 6:10-18

- (10) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.
- (11) Put on the whole armour of God that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of

- (16) Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.
- (17) And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:
- (18) Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Psalms 25:14

- (14) The secret of the LORD *is* with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant.

Isaiah 40:26-31

- (6) But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.
